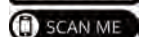

Fully accredited by the National Associations of Dance, Music, Theater and Art & Design, New World School of the Arts college students earn their Associate in Arts degree from Miami Dade College and their Bachelor of Fine Arts and Bachelor of Music degrees from the University of Florida, right in the heart of downtown Miami. The high school students, who also receive their diploma in the downtown campus, earn dual enrollment credits from Miami Dade College as students of New World School of the Arts.
