Transportation options

Metrorail

The Metrorail system is a 25-mile dual track, elevated rapid transit system in Miami-Dade County that provides service to Miami International Airport (MIA) and runs from Kendall through downtown Miami to Northwest Miami with connections to Broward and Palm Beach counties at the Tri-Rail / Metrorail transfer station.

New World School of the Arts students taking the Metrorail should exit at the *Government Center Station* which is under three blocks West of the school.

Students at NWSA can obtain a monthly Metrorail card for \$56 / month from https://transitstore.miamidade.gov
Fare is \$2.25 each way, or \$5.65 for a 1-Day Pass.

Metromover

The Metromover loops around the downtown Miami and Brickell areas and can be accessed from the Government Center Station, the Brickell Station and multiple smaller stations throughout the area. Fare is free.

Tri-Rail

The Tri-Rail system offers student fares at 50% of the regular fare with the EASY Card. Fares are flexible from \$2.50 to \$6.90.

Brightline

Service from Miami to Ft. Lauderdale to West Palm Beach. Fare is \$10 to \$15 round trip.

95 Express Bus

- Broward Blvd to downtown Miami (SE I St. and I Ave.) 2 blocks from NWSA.
- Last pick up going North is at 7 pm.
- Sheridan St. to downtown Miami (SE I and I Ave.)
- 2 blocks from NWSA.

Last pick up going North is at 6:45 pm. Fare is \$2.25 each way, or \$5.65 for a I-Day Pass
